PROJECT OVERVIEW

Ashburton Salt is a new solar salt project planned for an area south-west of Onslow, just across the Ashburton River.

Solar salt is the result of a naturally occurring process using the sun and wind to evaporate sea water – the same thing happens at the existing salt project in Onslow or salt lakes around the state.

The project is being developed by K+S Salt Australia, a local company established by German-based K+S. While K+S has operated salt and potash projects all over the world for more than 100 years, this is their first one in Australia.

Will Inject more than \$144 million into the Onslow region (including Exmouth and Karratha)



Provides a \$48 million a year boost into the Onslow region, which works out to just under \$2 billion over 40 years.



Will inject \$292 million into the Western Australian economy



would generate 270 construction jobs, with local contractors and suppliers used where possible and 90 permanent jobs for residents in the Onslow region once operational



has the potential to offer indefinite economic benefits through the use of renewable energy



Would see ongoing positions take home \$12.8 million by local employees each yeaR

ENVIRONMENTAL APPROVALS

We want to do the right thing – so we are taking our time with our environmental studies to make sure we gather the right information to adequately assess environmental risks.

This way we can develop Ashburton Salt in a way that minimises potential impacts to the environment.

Mangrove, algal mat, and marine communities as well as land-based flora and fauna are all being studied.

We are being open about what the project will look like and possible impacts - there are no secret agendas. We have intentionally relinquished tenement areas to the south of our project which had a high-level of interface with the Exmouth Gulf. Our objective is to minimise the interface with this sensitive environmental area by locating the project as far north as possible, nearer to Onslow.

We have and will continue to share results from our studies with the community along the way.
